has traveled throughout North America as well as South America, Australia and Africa. He was elected to the APHA board of directors in 1979 and has served as vice chairman since February 1982. Glen and his wife, Linda, have three sons and one daughter. All of the Klippenstein children are successfully showing Glenkirk cattle in junior shows and have started Polled Hereford herds of their own.

George Wingert started his family Polled Hereford operation, Wingert Stock Farm, 7 years ago and it has grown to a 2,000-acre, 300-cow farm. George and Jane Wingert's four children all own cattle and have an active role in the business.

Wingert has spent more than 25 years in the oil and farm implement business, but has a strong livestock background. He graduated from Kansas State

University in 1953 with a B.S. in agriculture and journalism. While at KSU he was active in the collegiate 4-H Club, the livestock judging team and the meats judging team. Following graduation, he served in the U.S. Army Veterinarian Corps.

Since 1964 Wingert has been owner and president of Wingert Oil Co., the largest petroleum distributing company in Kansas, and he has held offices in many professional societies. From 1970 to 1978, he served in the Kansas House of Representatives, where he was involved in government organization and ways and means committees. He is presently a member of the Kansas Board of Regents. Wingert is the sale committee chairman for the Franklin County Fair and is a state director for the Kansas Polled Hereford Association. He was elected to the APHA board of directors in 1981.

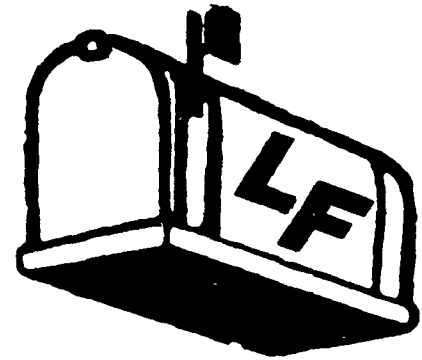
