

Huff Ranch scores big in Suffolk nat'l show

LOUISVILLE, Ky. — It was absolutely worth the trip," explained Doris Huff of Huff Ranch, Salem, OR, after capturing Grand Champion Ram, Grand Champion Ewe and Champion Flock in the National Suffolk Sheep Show at the North American International Livestock Exposition.

Doris and her husband Ben, traveled over 2,400 miles from their ranch in Salem, OR, to be part of the largest sheep show at the NAILE.

Huff Ranch's ram, The Baron, was slapped Grand Champion after winning the Yearling Ram Class. Judge Robbie Frost,

Bloomingsburg, OH, explained that the ram "filled the utilities of all aspects of the industry."

Frost went on to say that there are three people to please in the sheep industry: commercial breeders, club lamb traders, and purebred breeders. Each are looking for different traits in the

animal from size, to growth, to style.

The Reserve Grand Champion Ram went to New Genes of New Power Suffolks, Berlin Heights, OH. New Genes was the Jr. Ram Lamb winner.

Then Darrell Anderson, Windom, MN, stepped in to judge the ewe classes. Anderson stated he was looking for a ewe that typified the ideal Suffolk. The ewe should have frame, femininity, structural correctness and an over-all usefulness.

After that he went on to slap Pipestone G611 from Huff Ranch

as Grand Champion Ewe. Pipestone also placed first in the yearling class. Reserve Grand Champion honors went to Miss Nugget of B & L Livestock, Canby, OR, the second-place ewe in the Yearling Class.

Huff Ranch was not finished winning, however. They went on to receive yet, another award. Both judges, Frost and Anderson, agreed that Huff ranch had the Champion Flock at the show.

The last award of the show was given to Bill Heggemeier, Kirkland, IL, as Premier Exhibitor.
