Report supplied by USDA CATTLE: Compared to last week slaughter steers .50 higher. Heifers mostly steady. Cows 1.00 higher. Bulls near steady. Trade opened the week fairly active in response to an upward trending carcass beef trade. By midweek trade became only moderate with buyers less aggressive for numbers and very selective as to yield grade. Receipts this week about 3700 compared to 1723 a week ago and 5018 a year ago.
