Use Agronomy Guide for "profit"

practices recommended in the 1983 edition of the Penn State Agronomy Guide.

There are four basic production practices that will enable the farmer to collect higher yields and profits.

The farmer should know soil type and match the crop to it. The type can be found in the country's soil survey report. This report aids the farmer in determining the amount of limestone and fertilizer necessary to obtain a high crop yield.

As much energy as possible should be conserved in the soil. Corn expends the most energy, but by rotating with alfalfa every two years, some of this energy can be conserved.

For best results, farmers should use high quality seeds in planting. These seeds have a germination of 90 percent and contain few or no weeds.

Since pests are a big problem in crop production, the farmer should maintain a feasible pest control program. The program should be based on a combination of proven

methods.
