

Game Commission plans Game Protector class

HARRISBURG — The Pennsylvania Game Commission announced recently that the state Civil Service Commission is accepting applications for Game Conservation Officer Trainees.

The final date to apply to take a written examination for the positions will be Friday, Jan. 21, 1983.

Applicants who pass the written test, which will be given at various

testing centers located throughout the state, will be assigned to oral examinations to be held at a later date.

The examinations will ultimately provide a list of eligibles from which will be selected approximately 30 persons who will undergo a formal 40-week training program, beginning in July 1983, as Game Conservation Officer Trainees.

Most of the training will be conducted at the Pennsylvania Game Commission's Training School near Brockway, Jefferson County.

During the training program, trainees will be paid \$500.00 bi-weekly. Meals, lodging, uniforms, equipment, etc., will also be provided by the Game Commission.

Those who successfully complete

the training program will be eligible for promotion to the class of Game Conservation Officer at a current annual starting salary of \$17,317.

A Game Conservation Officer is responsible for the proper execution of all Game Commission programs and policies within an assigned geographical area, as a district game protector.

Game Conservation Officers are subject to 24-hour call, are frequently required to work long and irregular hours, and are exposed to an element of danger.

Applicants must be Pennsylvania residents, of good moral character, and physically capable of performing the duties of a game protector. In addition, they must be high school graduates or possess certification of equivalent training.

Anyone who applies will be required to possess a current Pennsylvania automotive operator's license at the time of entrance into the Training School. The applicant also must be able to pass job-related medical and physical fitness examinations as soon as possible following the oral examination.

Trainees are required to reside at the Training School during the training program.

There are no facilities available

at the school for the families of trainees.

After graduation from the Training School, officers must agree to reside and accept assignments to duty at any location throughout the state without regard to the location from which the employee was recruited. Game Conservation Officer assignments are based on manpower needs, and officers must accept rotating assignments as the Game Commission may require, irrespective of their length of service or marital or dependency status.

Applicants are subject to an indepth confidential character and loyalty investigation with results acceptable to the commonwealth before appointment.

Requirements for applicants follow:

As of July 1, 1983, applicants must be at least 21 years of age.

Height and weight must be proportional, with verification being made during the physical examination.

Must be able to pass vision test with each eye, and the applicant must have the ability to distinguish colors accurately and have normal depth perception.

Normal hearing perception is required.




