

Sheaffer, Stamy clinch Holstein wins

The junior champ, recently flushed to Osborndale Ivanhoe, appeared on the Eastern National and Maryland State tanbarks, last year.

John Stamy, III of Mechanicsburg first showed Manor Grove Marvex Cathy at Farm Show when she was a calf. Tuesday, marked her first tanbark appearance as a lactating cow. It also marked the day of the Cumberland County breeder's first Farm Show champion when Judge Dickson tagged the Marvex daughter as his Reserve Grand Champion.

Stamy explained the Holstein's next test of type will be later this month when she is scored for the first time in Stamy's 130-head milking herd. Mid-way through her first lactation, the reserve champ, bred to Plushanski Persuader, is

projected at 16,291 pounds of milk and 629 of fat.

Tioga County exhibitors Ida Jane and Leroy Plance of Wellsboro walked away with their share of ribbons and earned Premier Exhibitor honors.

Dumbelle Farms of Perry County reaped the benefits of a prize-winning show string, as well. Tom and Shayne Dum of Landisburg finished the day as the Holstein show's Premier Breeder.
