Fed cattle prices came under pressure all week as buyers sought to adjust live costs to declines in the beef trade. Demand proved generally unenthusiastic; but many interests were forced to

replenish skimpy line inventories. Consequently losses were held to a minimum. Many consignments carried considerable amounts of mud, and consequently suffered sometimes sharp discounts. "Short-Fed" kinds present in large numbers, while Y.G. #4 again on the decrease
