To make Bronco the most versatile no-till herbicide ever, we combined emerged weed control with seedling control—all in one jug. Seedling control for many of your worst annual grasses like foxtails, fall panicum and crabgrass, plus control of certain broadleaves like black nightshade and pigweed.

But our convenience extends beyond double-action weed control. Bronco herbicide requires only about half the normal carrier volume of typical paraquat tank mixes. That means fewer refills in the field and substantial savings in time and fuel.

For broad-spectrum preemergent broadleaf control, tank mix Bronco with Lorox, Sencor² or Lexone¹ in soybeans. In corn, tank mix with atrazine, Bladex³ or Princep⁴. Check our label for tank mix rates and recommendations.
