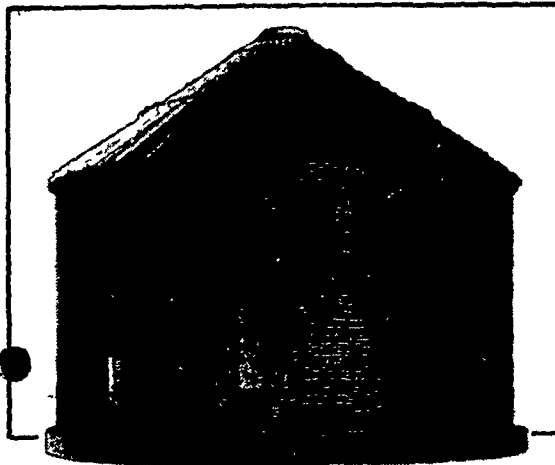
A representative of Eastern's management will update officers on Eastern's financial progress and discuss the proposed 1983-84 cooperative budget and other dairy issues.

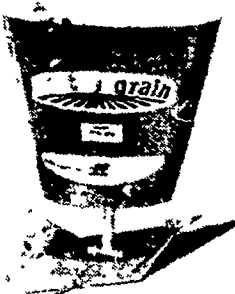

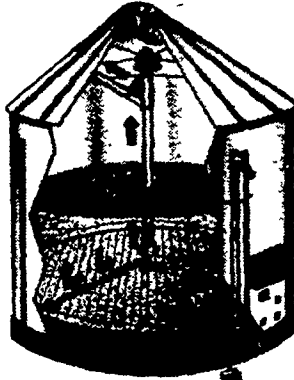
