Compared with the previous Wed. Slaughter Steers and Heifers .50 to mostly 1.00 higher. Trade supported by excellent two-way Feeder Steer outlet. Cows fully 1.00 lower, instances 2.00 off with 3.00-7.00 break on cow beef. Bulls 1.00 higher. Feeder Cattle 1.00 to mostly 2.00 higher, broad outlet from local Feeder buyers. Slaughter Steers for 3 days this week averaged 1156 lbs. compared with 1172 lbs. previous week and 1131 lbs. year ago. Marketings of Slaughter Steers and Heifers continue to appear very current with quality grade estimated at 75-80% Choice and less than 5% YG 4. Mud continues a major problem with most consignments carrying 1-2% body weight. This situation will not change for many weeks with shallow frost and abundance of snow cover. Supply included 300 cows and 3000 head of Feeder Cattle, inc. 2600 at Wed. Auction.

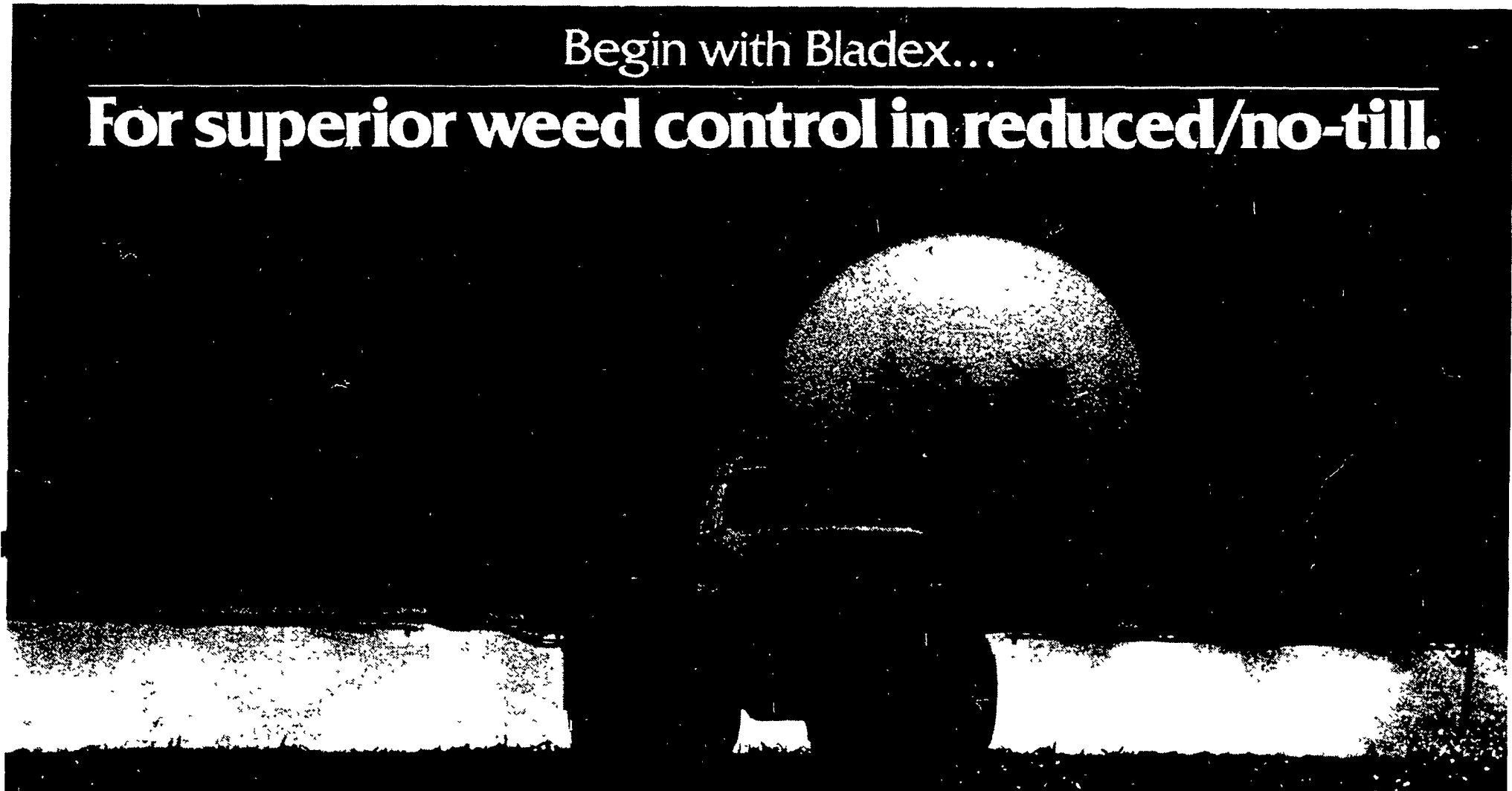
