(Continued from Page A10) In order to protect the producer from the danger of having excess residues in food and feed crops, it is very important that accurate records be kept. This is true on crops as well as with livestock. In case the producer is charged with excess residues, these written records may save your business. Don't rely on your memory or oral statements; they will not stand up at a hearing or in court. Be sure records list the name of the material, and the rate and date of application.




