Chester maple sugar fete next Saturday

WEST CHESTER — Learn to make maple syrup at home at Chester County's third annual Maple Sugar Festival next Saturday, March 12, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Hibernia Park.

This free event, sponsored by the Chester County Parks and Recreation Department, will be highlighted by informative demonstrations and exhibits on maple tree identification, collection devices, and a variety of maple sugar uses and recipes.

West Chester's Rural Rhythm String Band will provide old-time fiddle music and cloggers will perform. For a modest price, a tasty pancake and sausage breakfast, featuring homemade Hibernia syrup, will be served picnic-style throughout the day.

Hibernia Park is located approximately four miles north of Coatesville. From the Route 30 bypass, follow Route 82 North 1/4 mile. Turn left on Route 340 west for one mile. Make the first right after passing the Wagontown Fire Station and follow signs to the park. Raindate will be Sunday, March 13.
