Bloomsburg Fair will open Monday, Sept. 26 and continue day and night through Saturday Oct. 1. The Fair opens each day at 7 a.m. exhibition buildings are open 9 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Patterson also indicated contract negotiations have already been approved with performers for several of the Fair's Grandstand Night Shows. Their identities, however will not be released until the signed contracts are received.

The Bloomsburg Fair attracts patrons from throughout the state and many neighboring states. Last year's record-breaking attendance exceeded 500,000 patrons.

A pre-fair Special Country Music Show will be staged Saturday, Sept. 24 at 8 p.m. An All-Pro Rodeo will be featured Saturday afternoon, Sept. 24 at 1 p.m. Vesper Services proceed the official opening of the Fair, Sunday evening, September 25 at 7 p.m.

Over 1200 exhibits are displayed in permanent brick buildings including flowers, arts and crafts, agricultural and school exhibits, including 4-H, F.F.A. and F.H.A. Specious buildings also accommodate cattle, horses, goats, swine, poultry, rabbits and dogs. Other events include hoers racing, demolition derby, midget auto racing, wild west rodeo, horse and pony pulling, log sawing, puppet shows, petting zoo and band concerts.

Many people plan their vacation for Bloomsburg Fair Week and each year many inquires as to the dates for the Fair are received at the Fair Office. There is an easy formula—"the Fair always starts the third Monday after Labor Day"
