

Panel urges farmers

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1978. That's an 11 percent increase. New York has 935,000 dairy cows, two percent more than the 915,000 head of five years ago.

Minnesota has 890,000 head today, up 4.7 percent from the 850,000 head recorded in 1978. Pennsylvania has 738,000 head today, five percent more than the

703,000 head of five years earlier. Graf's conclusion to these statistics was that no one state is to blame for the surplus, but that several factors, including low feed prices, a depressed economy discouraging consumption, and

poor profitability in farming in general contributed to the increased production.

Though none of Tuesday's speakers had a feasible solution to the surplus problem, most repeated Graf's concerns and statistics. That afternoon a panel discussion was conducted by the following dairy representatives: Graf; Lynn Stalbaum, National

Milk Producers Federation; Edward Coughlin, director of the Ag Marketing Service with USDA's dairy division; Henry Geisinger, Pa. Association of Milk Dealers; George Brumbaugh, Pa. Milk Marketing Board; Boyd Cook, Inter-State Milk Producers' Coop.; and Alpheus Ruth, Lehigh Valley Farmers.

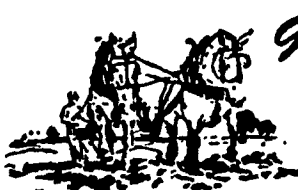
