

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Grant to benefit 4-H volunteers

LANCASTER — Pennsylvania will benefit from a broadened effort to strengthen volunteer leadership and help expand the 4-H program nationwide. The new program, called Salute to Excellence, will be implemented in 1983 as a result of 52 incentive grants of \$1,000 awarded this month to each state, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico.

The grants were made possible by support from R.J. Reynolds Industries, Inc., Winston-Salem, N.C. Last October, with support from Reynolds, one outstanding 4-H volunteer leader from each state was selected to attend a six-day intensive training session at the National 4-H Center. Mary Hosterman of Aaronsburg represented Pennsylvania. The

sessions were designed to prepare volunteers with creative ideas and skills to help 4-H leadership in their states devise innovative proposals for increasing volunteerism.

Mrs. Hosterman, working with professional staff at the state 4-H office at the Pennsylvania State University, has developed a plan to design and produce teaching aids for use by professional and volunteer staff. These visuals would help create a better understanding of the volunteer middle management concept and the ways volunteers can assume broader and more varied roles in expanding and strengthening 4-H.

The results from Pennsylvania and those from across the nation will be shared with volunteers nationwide through NATIONAL 4-H NEWS, the volunteer's magazine, next October.

The Salute to Excellence program was arranged by National 4-H Council in support of the 4-H program of the Cooperative Extension Service of the State Land-Grant Universities and the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

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
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
