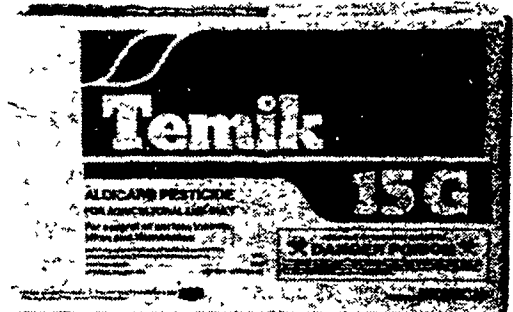
The livestock and poultry produced in Pennsylvania provide nutritious protein and many essential vitamins and minerals.
