minutes on the end of a long line is one of the best ways. Just let the horses run circles around you. This keeps him from getting fat and developing weak feet and legs.

Don't feed moldy, dusty or dirty hay or grain to horses; this could result in colic or respiratory problems. Free choice of clean water, salt and minerals should be provided. Good care now will help bring good performance during the rest of the year.
