Her dam, Maple-Lawn Elevation was rated as VG,88-5yr. She was born March 9, 1981 and was bred Sept. 82 to Sexation. Marilyn was consigned by Nelson Meyers of Greencastle. Her buyer, Harold Whittier, Whittier Farms, of Sutton, Mass, is well-known as a Holstein breeder. Whittier is the breeder of Whittier Farms Apollo Rocket, sold to ABC.


The sale total for all three sales combined was \$219,350, with a sale average of \$2109 for the 104 head
