Individual cow records of 305 days or less, over 750 pounds of butterfat are:

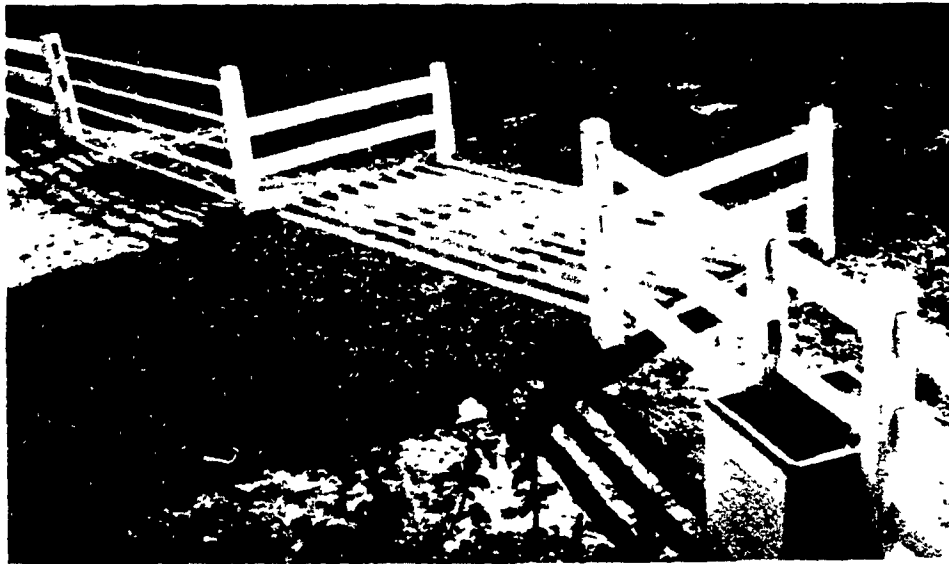

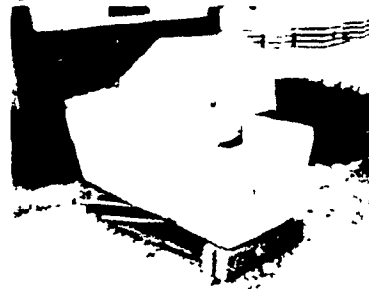

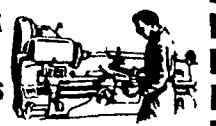
