WASHINGTON, D.C. - A three-finding Edwards guilty of conmonth prison sentence issued by a Federal court for David (Bucky) Edwards, of Nicholson, has been suspended provided Edwards pay a \$3,000 fine, a U.S. Department of Agriculture official said today.

B.H. Jones, head of USDA's Packers and Stockyards Administration, said Edwards purchases livestock throughout Pennsylvania and central and southern New York.
