## Omaha Cattle

Thursday, April 7  
**Report Supplied By USDA**  
 Weekly 51—CATTLE—compared to previous week's close slaughter steers and heifers ended the week 50-1.00 higher. Cows weak to fully 1.00-lower. Bulls steady.  
 Fed cattle prices continued their upward climb reaching 9 month highs and marking the fifth consecutive week of advancing markets. Tight supply of "ready" cattle kept buyers inventories on the short side, consequently demand to most interests good through the session. Advances in dressed beef provided day-to-day support, moving up a full 3.00 by midweek. Overall finish (not too attractive) and mud both ongoing problems in the trade with little relief in sight, considering rain-snow conditions prevalent this week. Steers comprised 46 pct of the week's receipts; Heifers 40 pct; cows 5 pct; feeders 8 pct. Four

day receipts 9702; last week 6812; year ago 8087.
