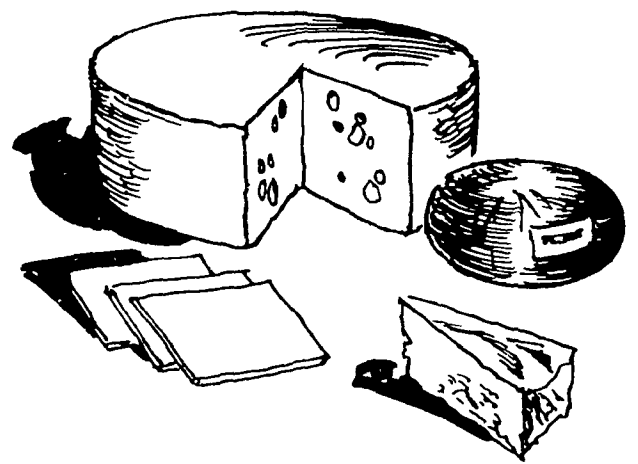
High Cow

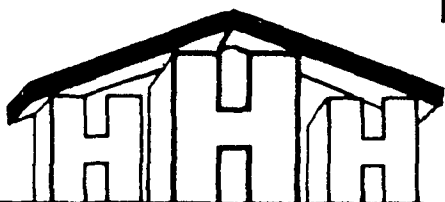
