Second high lactation was completed by a Registered Holstein cow owned by Gerald Martin, R 1, Ephrata. Kathy produced 27,888 lbs of milk, 1,021 lbs of butterfat with a 3.7% test in 305 days.

First 305 days of lactation with 720 or more lbs of butterfat

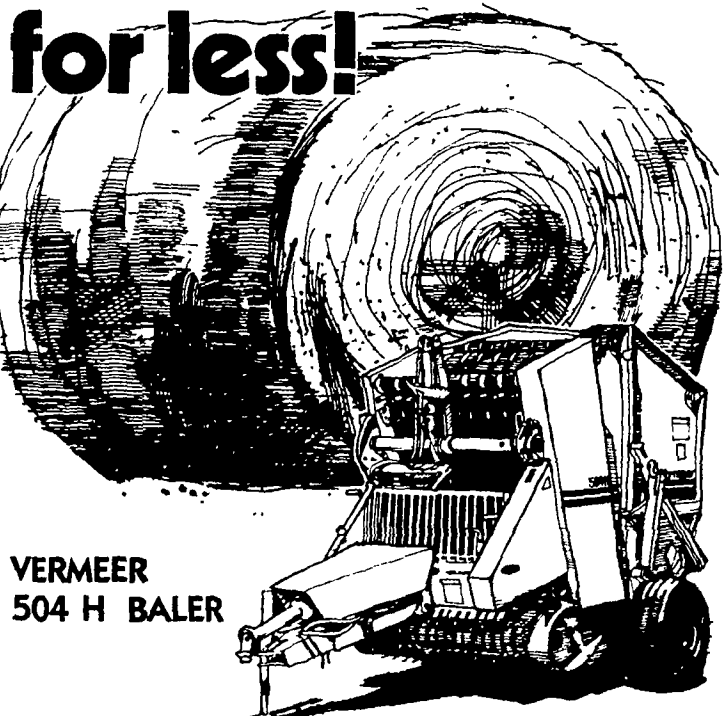
