Slaughter Bulls steady to 1.00 lower with Yield Grade 1-2 1100-1500 lb. 46.70-53.00; 1500-1800 lb. 49.00-57.00, package 2275 lb. very high dressing 58.75 early. Salable receipts this week near 28,300 head compared with 20,506 head last week and 22,371 head last year. Bulk of receipts consisted of Feeder Steers and Heifers; Cows and Bulls made up 7 percent of salable supply.
