

Lehman's Egg Service gets energy award

HARRISBURG — Tuscarora School District, of Mercersburg, and Lehman's Egg Service, of Greencastle, Monday received awards for energy conservation from the Governor's Energy Council (GEC).

The awards were presented by Sen. William J. Moore and Rep. Terry Punt in Senator Moore's office at the Main Capitol Building. The Tuscarora School District award was accepted by Dr. Ted Rabold, Superintendent. The

school district has implemented two new energy curriculum choices which allow senior students the opportunity to work on campus energy projects. Projects such as operating a bio-mass plant and solar oven, recording wind

speeds, constructing and working in a solar greenhouse have already been implemented.

"Because of this program, Tuscarora School District graduates will be more conscious of the need for conservation and

alternative methods of producing energy," said Senator Moore. "It is my hope that other school districts will begin similar programs to enrich the educational experiences of their students."

The Lehman's Egg Service Award was received by Galen Buckwalter, company president, for substantial reduction of their electrical consumption. This savings resulted from installing a trash burner in the physical plant, which is designed to burn waste such as packing material and corrugated boxes, producing heat for the egg washers.

"Not only have the trash removal expenses been eliminated, but so has the cost of fuel used in heating their process hot water," Moore continued. "Lehman's Egg Service is leading the way for other commercial volume hot water users to look to trash and other burnable waste as a valuable fuel."

The GEC offers awards to businesses, commercial establishments, local governments, private organizations, agricultural concerns and individuals who are involved with an energy saving program or have used alternative energy resources. The award applicant must have proven energy reduction over a 12 month period or must demonstrate creative approaches to saving energy.

The Governor's Energy Council is a 19 member group of public and private sector representatives who advise the Commonwealth on energy related issues. The council is chaired by Lieutenant Governor William W. Scranton III.

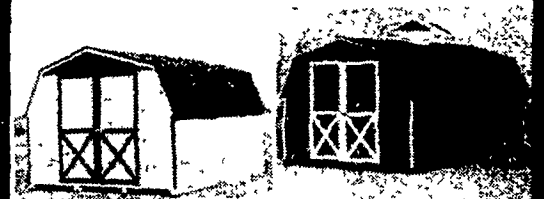
