## Red meat

### production drops

HARRISBURG — Pennsylvania's April commercial red meat production totaled 77.1 million pounds, down three percent from the previous month, according to the Pennsylvania Crop and Livestock Reporting Service.

Beef production for the month totaled 68.6 million pounds, with 76,400 head slaughtered and an average liveweight of 1,160 pounds. Veal production was 4.0 million pounds. Total head slaughtered was 24,100 with an average liveweight of 167 pounds.

Pork production during April totaled 37.5 million pounds. Total head killed was 162,300 with an average liveweight of 231 pounds. Lamb and mutton output totaled 1.2 million pounds. Total head slaughtered was 12,000 with an average liveweight of 99 pounds.

Nationally, commercial red meat production for April totaled 3.04 billion pounds, down seven percent from the previous month. Beef production totaled 1.73 billion pounds. Total head killed was 2.76 million and liveweight averaged 1,068 pounds per head. Veal production was 32 million pounds. Calf slaughter of 224,000 head averaged 244 pounds liveweight.

Port production totaled 1.25 billion pounds. Hog kill totaled 7.22 million head. Average liveweight for the month was 243 pounds. Lamb and mutton production was 30 million pounds. Head slaughtered of 523,000 averaged 115 pounds liveweight.
