Slaughter bulls closed steady for the week with YG 1 1250-1400 lb. 50.10-51.50 in limited supply; 1400-1835 lb. 52.25-55.25, individual 1660 lb. 57.00. Salable receipts this holiday shortened week estimated at 19,200 head compared with 28,698 head last week and 19,007 head the comparable period a year ago. Bulk of the weeks receipts consisted of feeder steers and heifers; cows and bulls made up 6 percent of salable supply.
