

### Prize winning cheese displays

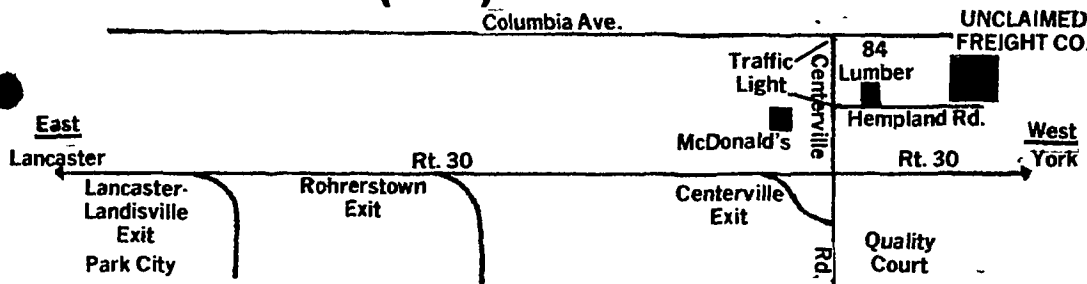
SYRACUSE — The American Dairy Association and Dairy Council (ADA/DC) hosted a special awards dinner last week for Tops supermarket managers who were winners in the 1982 "Cheese Adds a Slice of Life" foodstore display contest. New York State retailers claimed 33 prizes in the nationwide contest,

including a 2nd place winner, with 18 of those prizes going to Tops. Kevin Wert, a Tops supermarket employee from Buffalo was the 2nd place winner. He received a Litton microwave oven. A duplicate prize went to his cheese sale representative, Hank Wahl of Blackman and Ebsary, for his assistance in the winning display.

There were 316 winners selected from the 1,850 entries. In order to enter, foodstore personnel built promotional displays for domestic cheese using the "Slice of Life" theme. They were judged on the basis of originality, attractiveness, use of theme and incorporation of sound merchandising principles.

the waterfalls and the Italian Water Garden.

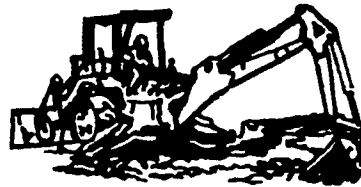
