

Berwick vegetable co-op to meet

BERWICK — Three decades of continual progress will be next marked at the annual dinner meeting of Berwick Vegetable Cooperative scheduled for Saturday, June 11 at Maria Assunta Hall, Monroe Street, Berwick.

Registration for members and area farm leaders will begin at 6 p.m., with a home-style dinner served an hour later.

George Hubbard, Luzerne County Executive Director of Agriculture Stabilization and Conservation, will be guest speaker. His topic "Do You Need a National Farm Program?" He is a 1969 graduate of Penn State University with a degree in Dairy Production. His tour of duty with the armed forces covered a period of three years with the Navy aboard the Destroyer U.S.S. Kennedy in Saigon, South Vietnam. For four years he was parts and service representative for John Deere, New Holland machine dealer at Montrose.

For the past ten years, he served in his directorship capacity for Luzerne County ASC Committee, a post which won for him many commendations.

His address which will begin at about 8:30 p.m. ought to be of interest to agricultural and agribusiness people who attend the event. Following Hubbard's talk, the annual business meeting of Cooperative members will be held.

Berwick Vegetable Cooperative has a large warehouse, distribution center and offices at 1865 Spring Garden Avenue, Berwick.


Founded to provide a produce marketing service and farm supply purchasing service to

vegetable and potato growers of several counties surrounding Berwick, the cooperative has grown tremendously. It now has 152 members. Keyed to progressive




