During the month there were 124 herds with 6,429 cows processed in the D.H.I.A. program, according to Russell C Seward, County Agent. Production ranged from a high of 66.5 pounds of milk, testing 4.0 percent fat, to a low of 22.2 pounds of milk, testing 4.1 percent fat.

In the owner-sampler program there were 22 herds with 849 cows being processed. The herds ranged from a high of 64.2 pounds of milk, testing 3.4 percent fat, to a low of 28.2 pounds of milk, testing 3.7 percent fat.

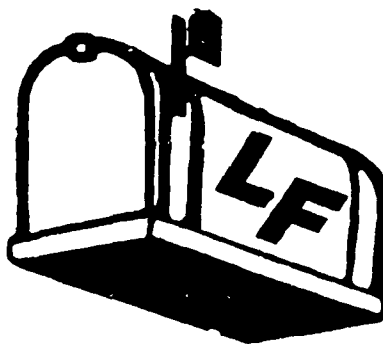
