For The Week: Compared to last week feeder steers and heifers under 600 lb. closed 2.00-4.00 lower; over 600 lb. 1.00-1.50 lower. Slaughter cows were firm to 50 cents higher with Wednesday sales of Utility and Commercial 2-3 40.60-42.75; Cutters 1-2 39.10-41.90; Canners and Low-Cutters 35.00-38.20. Bulls closed weak to 1.00 lower with YG 1 1350-1400 lb. 51.00-53.25, Individual 1400 lb. very high dressing 56.00. Salable receipts this week near 19,800 head compared with 18,469 head last week and 16,010 head last year. Bulk of this week: receipts consisted of feeder steers and heifers; Cows and Bulls made up 10 percent of salable supply.

Weekly 51 — CATTLE —

Slaughter steers, two-way steer and slaughter heifers on Wednesday's close ranged 1.50-2.00 lower than previous week's close. Cows 1.00-1.50 lower. Bulls steady.

Fed cattle trading followed the same pattern of the last four weeks with packers constantly pressing for sharply lower costs while two-way interests remained extremely aggressive. The large purchases of 1000-1150 lb. steers, to return to feedlots, prevented prices from falling even more drastically than did occur. Overall finish ran the poorest in some time with many steers and heifers falling into the good-low choice bracket.

Four Day Receipts 11858; Week Ago 14409; Last Year 7442. Steers comprised 50 pct of the week's receipts, heifers 38 pct, cows 8 pct; feeders 3 pct.

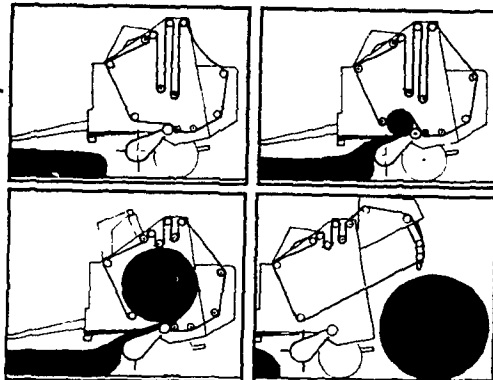
