Slaughter Steers in the 1050-1150 lbs. yield grade 2-3 range remain the most sought after with other weights and grades under pressure as the wholesale beef trade works to lower price levels. Receipts this week about 3100 as compared to 2524 a week ago and 2366 a year ago.
