

# Gypsy moth programs are varied

WASHINGTON, D.C. — There are no exciting air bike chases or encounters with ewoks in the Gypsy Moth Wars, but the U.S. Department of Agriculture is using every available weapon short of a light saber this year to stop the "Return of the Gypsy" outside its "empire."

"We're using lure-baited traps, chemical and biological insecticides and other means," said Gary Moorehead, a plant health official in USDA's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service.

USDA is working with states to detect and eradicate the gypsy moth outside the generally infested Northeast.

"In its caterpillar stage, the moth strips leaves of forest, shade and ornamental trees, killing some trees and weakening others," said Moorehead. "The caterpillars can become a nuisance around homes and make outdoor recreation areas unusable."

"We use traps to detect outlying infestations and use various means to get rid of these infestations," he said.

The cardboard traps are baited with moth pheromone - a sex attractant - to attract the male moths. Once trapped, a moth becomes stuck in a sticky substance or is killed with insecticide.

Moorehead said this spring and summer eradication operations are being conducted in 11 states, in locations where moths trapped in past years indicate infestations are present. Methods used vary from chemical or biological insecticides to mass trapping or treatment with the pheromone, which is being tested for its ability to confuse the moths and prevent mating.

"We use whatever method is most appropriate for the particular area," Moorehead said, "depending on the size and intensity of the infestation, environmental sensitivity of the location and wishes of state and local governments and area residents."

"Even though we think we can get rid of these infestations, in cooperation with state governments, we'd much rather keep them from reaching outlying areas," Moorehead said.

"If you're traveling from infested to non-infested areas you should examine your vehicles and other outdoor articles to make sure you leave any insects behind," he said.

"If you find an egg mass, scrape it into a can of kerosene or bleach."

"Moth egg masses - present from July through April - are the life stage that most often hitchhike with people, but caterpillars or cocoon-like pupae can also do so at other times of the year," he said.

Moorehead said USDA cooperative eradication projects are conducted only in outlying areas.

"In the infested northeastern and mid-Atlantic regions, USDA's Forest Service cooperates with state governments in projects that suppress the moths to prevent serious damage in residential or high-value timber areas," he said.

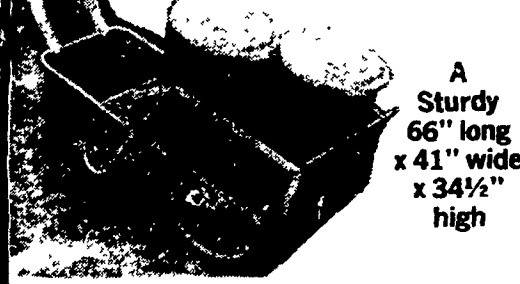

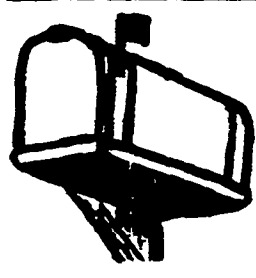
