Sired by PS Power Play, the heifer was chosen by judge David Sleigh of Ontario, Canada, from a field of 78 entries. Reserve grand champion heifer honors went to HF Queen Mother 267, owned by Huntington Farm, Alexandria, and sired by PS Mastermind.

Receiving reserve grand champion junior honors was a heifer owned by Rishels Edlyn Farm and Genetics Unlimited, West Grove. The heifer, named Edlyns Lady Evelyn 201, was sired by PS Power Paly.

The grand champion bull title was won by Kruegers Foolish Pride, owned by Fred Frey and Sons and the Greg Krueger Family, West Grove. The reserve honors went to PS Super Play, owned by Mark J. Barnett, Quamby, Hagly, Tasmania; Mrs. L.K. Kerr, Tibooburra Angus, Victoria Australia; and Penn State University.

Two Continental daughters took the champion and reserve champion bred and owned junior heifer titles. Guy McKean, Mercer, and his heifer MB Collie Con won the champion title. The reserve honors went to Ernest Frey II,

Quarryville, and his heifer Twin Oaks Kyma.


