Women in the Association baked hundreds of cakes, tables and chairs were set up and then it was time to work the serving line.



The weather was perfect - not too hot, not too cold - and although there was no official tally Friday, it was decided by the officers that "over 4,000 were served". This is out!


not the most ever served. In 1961, approximately 4800 people tasted Golden Guernsey homemade ice cream at the annual social.
