

Rotary cutters from Bush Hog feature 30 percent decrease in number of parts.

Bush Hog reports rotary cutters

SELMA, Al. — The new 250 Series rotary cutters by Bush Hog feature streamlined design, lower purchasing prices and Bush Hog's trademark of quality.

The new design eliminates 30 percent of the parts, a money-saving improvement; yet, extensive testing has proved that the new models handle loads better than the cutters they replaced.

Strength has been achieved through use of primary members, called strongbacks, built into deck frames. Other strength features include attachment of the gearbox base assembly directly to the framing members, a Z-band design, and unitized steel deck construction.

The deck design improves the looks while eliminating pockets that could trap water or trash. Rear deck tapering gives better trash flow without windrowing.

Optional economical safety chains that bolt on can be replaced individually. Front safety chains tuck under the skids to completely enclose the cutter, reducing the

possibility of thrown objects.

Features that are optional on many cutters are standard on the 250 Series. All three models feature round blade holders and slip clutches as standard equipment. The pull model is self-leveling with

manual or hydrolic height adjustment. The gearbox cover is removable for easy service and maintenance.

Cutters are available in 5-, 6- and 7-foot medium-duty models.

report, index of 1982 tests, Nebraska Tractor Test Law and a summary of tractor tests from 1973-1982.

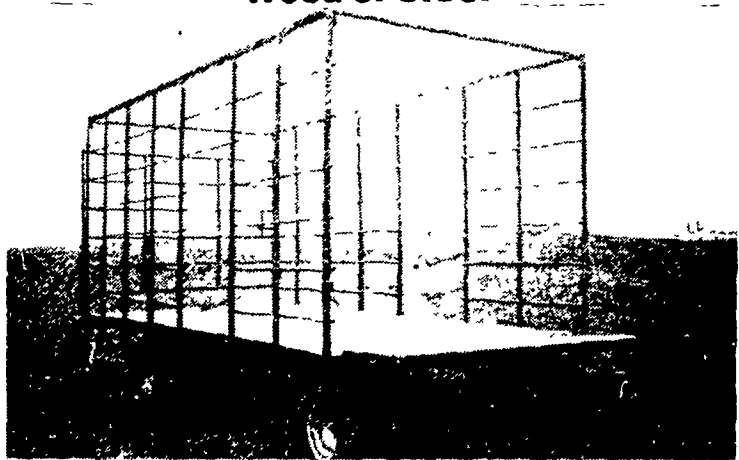

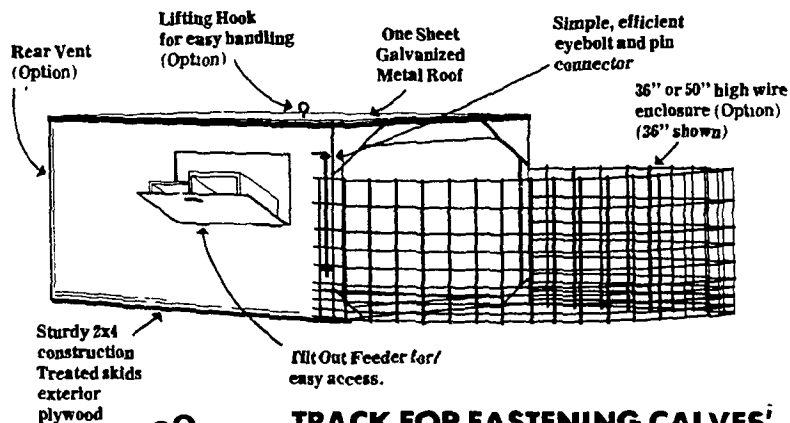
