

MARKET COMMENT: Prices are unchanged to higher. Trade sentiment is mostly steady, although an underlying cautiousness is apparent. First of the month buying interest varies from place to place and movement is erratic. Best interest centers around limited promotional activity. Supplies are in a slightly better position on extra large but still close while large and medium continue to easily handle all requests.
