Automated Planting  
Number 9 of a Series

The laborious task of planting crops was beginning to show signs of mechanization in the 1800's with the introduction of planting drills. Seeds were punched into the ground by a revolving cylinder with holes in its surface. These types of "drills", or planters, were either pushed forward using manpower or were pulled through the rows by horses. By 1900, six to ten acres per day could be planted with the help of these primitive machines.




Today a farmer can plant in excess of 100 acres a day in the high plains with the use of modern air seeders.




