CATTLE: Compared to last Monday slaughter steers unevenly steady, although few mostly Prime 50-1.00 higher; heifers steady; cows weak to 1.00 lower; bullocks 1.00-2.00 lower; bulls uneven, generally 1.00-2.00 lower. Supply included 72% slaughter steers, 10% slaughter heifers, 10% cows, and 8% bulls.

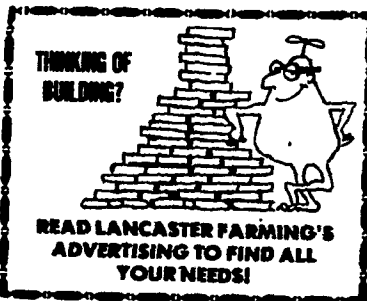
