

Queens Manor dominates NW Pa. Holstein Show

MEADVILLE — Queens Manor Leadfield Associates, which dominated the earlier Western Pa. Championship Show, outdid itself at the Northwest Pa. Holstein Show at the Crawford County Fairgrounds on Wednesday. Queens Manor's Ed Doeberiener collected 14 blues, including the

senior and grand champion laurels in the 413-entry field at Wednesday's show. In the W. Pa. Championship the Leadfield Associates string had garnered 12 blues. The senior and grand champion is a senior two-year-old, C. Apoulo

Fenelope Fury, classified VG-87, and owned by Queens Manor Alstar Holsteins and Brubacher Brothers. Breeder is Reagan Daigle. Fury earlier had taken first-place in the three-year-old class at the Quebec Spring Show, where

age grouping is different. Sired by Mississippi Fury, her dam is Apoulo Baronet Penelope. She was also an honorable mention senior yearling All American in 1982. In all, the Queens Manor Leadfield entries took blues in junior calf, senior yearling, junior get of sire, dry cow four years and

under, dry cow five years and over, junior two year old, senior two year old (the senior and grand champion), five year old, best udder by owner bred, best 3 females, produce of dam, daughter-dam, dairy herd and senior bull calf (champion bull). Records broken at Venango Fair sale

FRANKLIN — Sixty head of livestock were sold at the Venango Co. 4-H Market Livestock Sale last week at the Venango Fair. Record prices were set for the Grand Champion Market Lamb, Grand Champion Market Hog and Reserve Champion Hog. The Grand Champion Market Hog owned by Jeff Ritts of Seneca sold for \$5.50 per pound. The 245 lb. porker was purchased by Fryburg Roller Mills. The shattered record of \$3.00 stood only since 1982. Also outdone was the 1982 Reserve Champion Hog price of \$2.80 per pound. Jeff's brother Scott owned the Reserve Hog

which weighed in at 235 lbs. and was purchased by the First National Bank of Franklin for \$3.50 per lb. Also at the 8th annual 4-H Market Livestock Sale April McQuistons' six-month-old, 125 pound Suffolk took the spotlight as he sold for \$5.75 per lb. to the First National Bank. Top dollar had been \$3.50 paid in 1980. April is a 4-Her from Harrisville. She mentioned that her lamb was "sold" again to raise money for a new PA system. Reserve Grand Champion Market Lamb sold for \$3.25 per lb. to Titusville Agway. The 115 pound lamb was owned by Bonnie Ross, a member of the Cherrytree

Chargers 4-H Club, from Titusville. Lamb owners have another chance to garner a Grand Champion at Venango. Dick Shaffer, leader of the Cherrytree Chargers, mentioned that there is a "pair of lambs" class. These are then sold as a pair at the Livestock Sale. This year Grand Champion Market Pair of Lambs went to Taylor Cotton. He was paid \$1.45 per lb. by Gahrs Market for a total of 246 pounds. Reserve Gr. Ch. pair owner Darrin Shaffer received \$1.20 per lb. for 259 lbs. of lamb from Mowry Meats. Shaffer pointed out this was the first year 4-Hers were limited in the number of projects they could

sell. "They can sell two projects", he said. This means they could sell a pair of lambs as one project and still have a lamb, hog or steer. They are limited to one steer though. Grand Champion Market Steer sold for \$1.80 per pound. The buyer for the 1200 lb. animal was Fryburg Roller Mills. Owner Troy Shearer was proud of his Simmental Hereford. The 1400 lb. Reserve Champion Steer sold to Titusville Agway for \$1.10 per pound. Lori Gilliland of Emlenton of Venango County owned the Simmental Hereford.

The Reserve Grand Champion was shown by Morrell Farms, of R3 Cochran. Merrillea Citamatt Marie, bred by Alan Merrill, took first place in the three year olds. The reserve champ's sire is Sir Glenridge Citamatt and the dam is Frogmore High Mia. The grand-dam has records to 19,322 milk and 779 fat and is classified VG-88. The reserve champion bull, the second place senior bull calf, was exhibited by Marlene Baxter, of Stoneboro, Mercer County. She also had the reserve junior champion, the second place senior yearling. The junior champion was shown by Justin Doeberiener. She was the first place senior yearling.

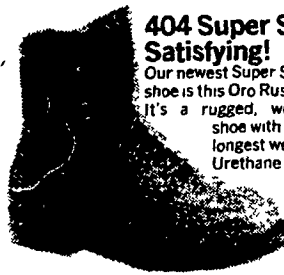

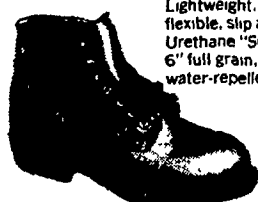
