Keystone National Bank of Dayton purchased the 648 pound Grand Champion Steer Carcass for \$2.60 a pound. Shown by John Granat of Clarksburg this steer was Graded Choice, had a fat thickness of 0.2, internal fat thickness of 3.0, 12.4 square inch rib eye, and a yield of 2.1.

Alan Weigand of Ford City sold his Reserve Champion Steer

Carcass for \$3.60 to Kittanning Shop 'N Save. Weigand's steer also graded choice, had a fat thickness of 0.4, internal fat thickness of 2.0, rib eye of 14.7, and yielded 2.3.

When the dust finally settled after this exciting sale the total paid by area businesses was over \$56,000 dollars for 29 hogs, 33 sheep, 19 steers, and 6 carcasses.

Less than one week after the sale the Junior Livestock Exhibitors will have held an appreciation banquet for all of the buyers who supported the sale and will continue to express their thanks throughout the year by supporting these local businesses.

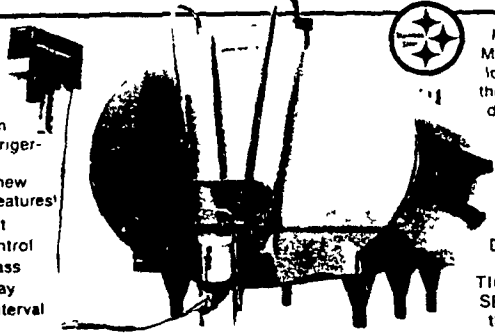

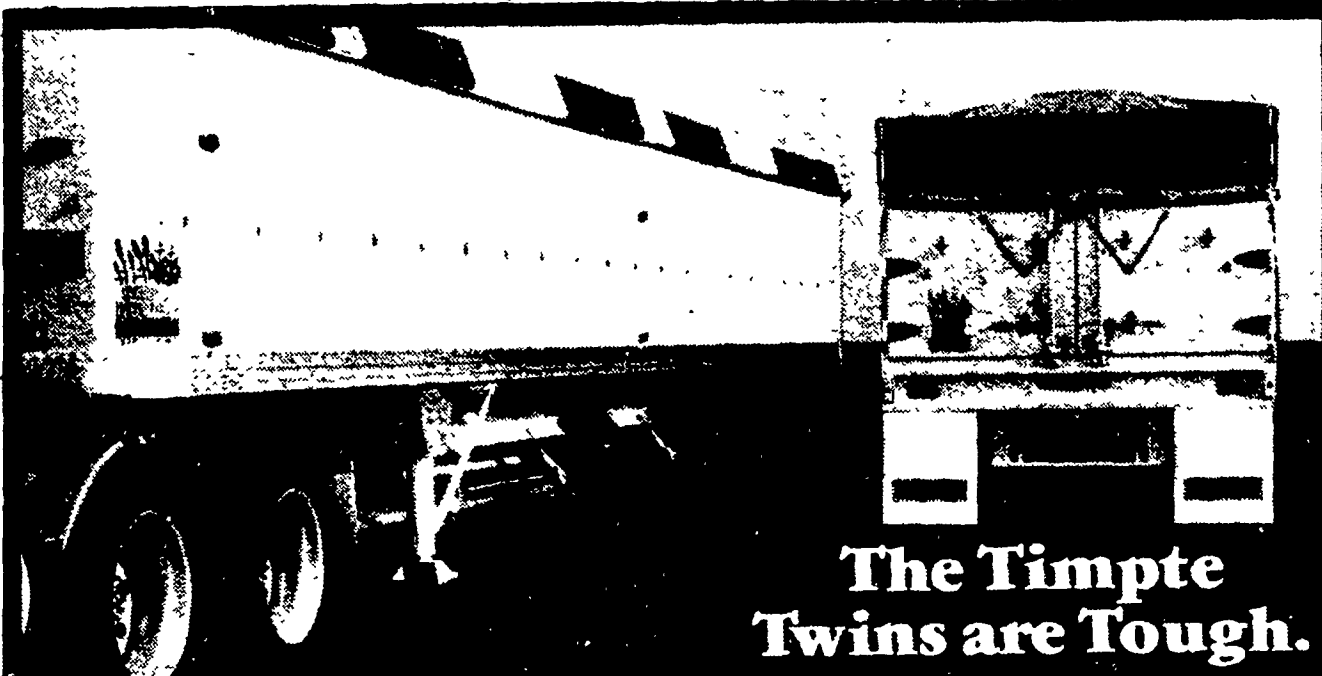

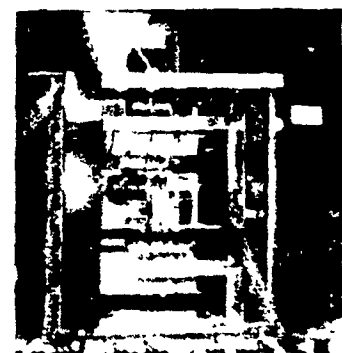
