The Senior Champion Holstein was "Elsie," the four-year old owned by Jennifer Weimer, New Oxford R2. Jenny also showed the Junior Champion, a senior yearling and won honors as reserve Master Showman and Reserve Champion Fitter.

Eric Keller, son of Mr. and Mrs. Patrick Keller, 420 Granite Station Rd., Gettysburg, showed his first calf, a Holstein, to first place honors in the Junior Calf Class. Lane Mummert showed the first place intermediate calf and went on to win Mini-showman honors among first and second year members. Kathleen Todd, Hanover R4, showed the first place junior yearling Holstein. Her sister, Christine, was named Champion

Fitter of the show.

The best Junior 2-year-old class was shown by Josephine Hess; Jim Ludwig placed first in the 3-year-old class.

In the Jersey breed, a junior yearling shown by Kathy Reever was named Junior Champion and helped her win reserve mini-showman honors. The Reserve Junior Champion and the Senior Champion honors were claimed by Carol Hobaugh.

Dawn and Todd Meyers each showed a Brown Swiss, winning Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion honors respectively.

Three Guernseys appeared in the 4-H round-up, all shown by Susan Murren, Hanover R4. They were designated Junior Champion, Senior Champion, and Reserve Senior Champion for the breed.

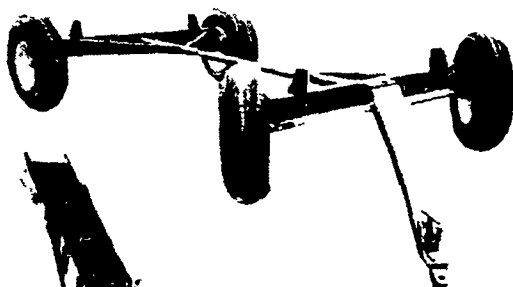
