



#### IMPOSSIBLE PEANUT BUTTER 'N CHOCOLATE PIE

- 1 cup packed brown sugar 1/2 cup Bisquick baking mix
- 2 eggs 1 cup whipping cream
- 2/3 chunky peanut butter 1 package (6 ounces) semisweet
- chocolate chips Heat oven to 350 degrees. Beat all ingredients except chocolate chips in large bowl on high speed.

scraping bowl occasionally, until fluffy, one minute (do not use blender). Pour into ungreased pie plate. Bake until puffed and dry in center and knife inserted in center comes out clean, about 35 mintues. Cool slightly.
