Yellow jackets more frequently definitely pose a problem and build nests in the ground as do cıcada killers. But cıcada kıllers The nests of wasps have are solitary wasps (as are mud characteristic forms and are found daubers) while yellow jackets live

in colonies (as do hornets and polistes.) Cicada killers and mud daubers are not considered to be aggressive. The other wasps, by nature and numbers are a greater hazard.

Several insecticides are available for wasp control. In general, a spray is used for above ground nests and a dust for in ground nests and hidden nests, within walls for example. Several commercial wasp sprays are available. Sevin may be used as a spray and is recommended for dusting procedures. Products containing resmethrin are also


