Weekly 51 - Cattle - At week's end slaughter steers and heifers ranged steady to 50 cents lower than previous week's close.

Early week losses mostly recovered at mid-session, influenced by advances in the dressed beef trade. Overall finish, particularly on heifers, rather attractive as optimum feeding weather prevails in the Omaha trade area. Cows steady to 1.00 lower, instances 2.00 down, most

decline on canner and low cutter. Bulls 1.00 lower.

Steers comprised 29 percent of the week's receipts; Heifers 31 percent, Cows 4 percent, Feeder 35 percent. Four day receipts 8486; Week ago 7955; Year ago 9144.

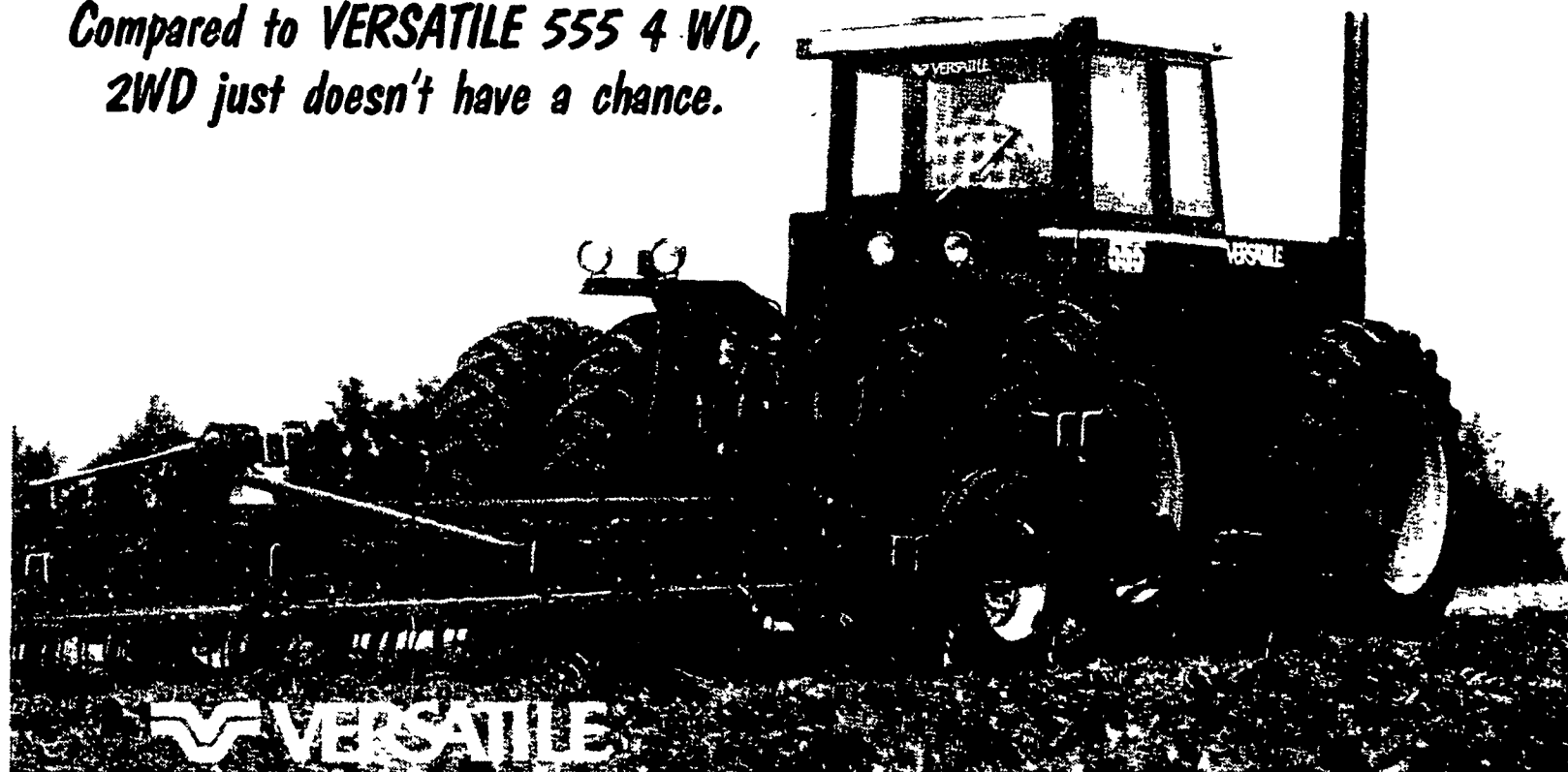
