The daughter of Vance Getz and Patricia Kimbark, Leah and her 124-pound Suffolk named Stretch walked off with grand champion honors at the Manheim Farm Show amidst a field of 130 entries. A member of the Lancaster County 4-H Woolies Club, Leah showed for only her second year.

Her champion lamb was bred on Trinity Farm, owned by her stepfather, John Kimbark. Stretch was fed a specially mixed ration and was walked for about an hour every day.



Tom, the son of William and Peggy Longenecker, R2 Mount Joy, said he didn't think his lamb would make its weight class and had no expectations of winning a title. But his lamb had the finish that judge Bill MacCauley, Atglen, was looking for in his champions.

The Longeneckers raise a 350head breeding flock and 250 market lambs. Tom said he plans to show as long as he's in 4-H or until he begins college.
