2. Make a face on the upper part of the shell with the pens. Try

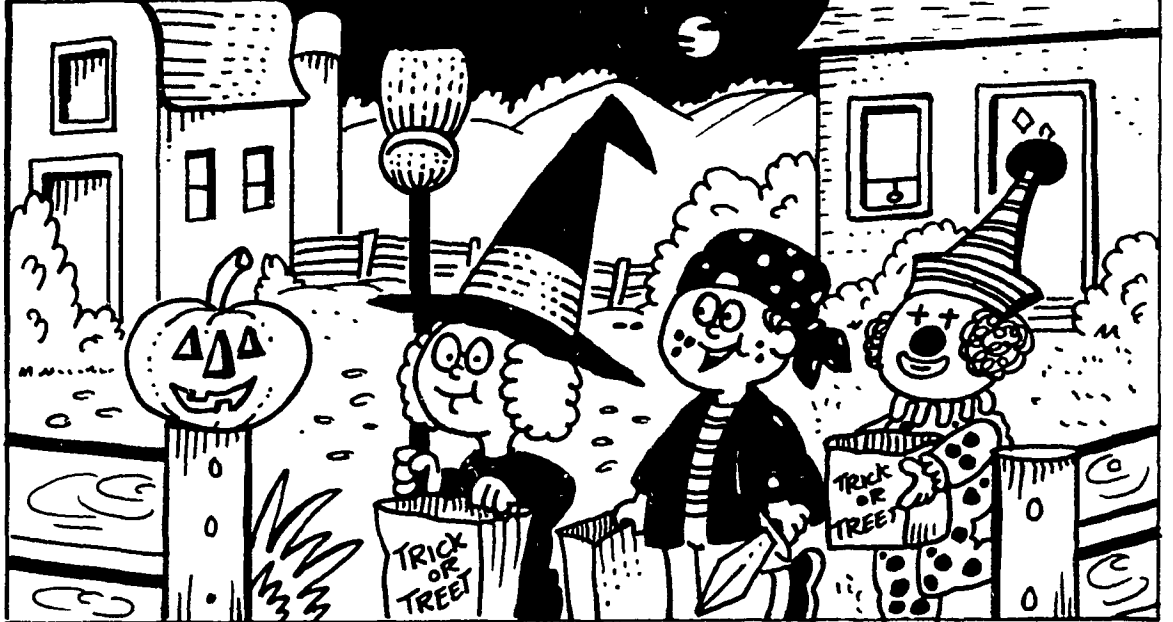
