Trade fairly active. Demand good, except on Feeder Heifers over 600 lb. which was moderate. Good moisture conditions for fall and winter grazing increased outlets for cattle suitable for grazing. Compared to last Wednesday, Feeder Steers and Heifers under 600 lb. were 1.00-2.00 higher. Feeder steers over 600 lb. steady to 50 cents higher; Feeder Heifers over 600 lb. steady to 1.00 lower. Slaughter Cows were 1.00-2.00 higher with breaking Utility and Commercial 2-3 35.50-38.50; Cutter and Boning Utility 1-2 32.75-38.00; Canners and Low-Cutters 26.00-33.00, several 28.00-32.00. Good moisture conditions for fall and winter grazing also increased demand for cows suitable to go back to the country for grazing. Slaughter Bulls were 3.00-4.00 higher with yield grade 1 1100-1500 lbs. 42.00-52.00, several 47.00-50.00; 1500-1900 lb. 50.00-53.25. Salable receipts this week estimated at 19,500 head compared with 19,726 head last week and 27,585 head last year. Majority of receipts were Feeder Steers and Heifers; Cows and Bulls made up 11 percent of estimated supply.
