Compared last week, slaughter steers and heifers closing mostly steady after slight upturns offset Tuesday by price declines. Cows 3.00-5.00 lower. Bulls 4.00-5.00 lower. Price declines in cows and buils apparently the result of sharp declines in wholesale cows and

trade. Slaughter supply fully 50% steers, near 30% heifers and fully 15% cows.
