

# Veal seminar on Wednesday

HARRISBURG — Two Pennsylvania Veal growers, Wayne Marcho and Walter Newton, are featured speakers at the Northeast Regional Veal Seminar, Wednesday at Cornell University, Ithaca, N.Y. The one-day conference is set to address marketing

and drug residue advances in the veal industry.

Wayne Marcho, a veal grower, of Harleysville, Montgomery County, who is Director of the American Veal Association, is slated to explain "A Vertically Integrated Veal Operation." Marcho raises

approximately 3,600 calves through his fully integrated operation each year. He is also presenting an up-date on state and national veal check-off programs.

Walter Newton, of New Albany, Bradford County, is a panel member to discuss "The Packers

Outlook on Veal Marketing...their standards and requirements", along with General Manager of Provimi, Inc. and Chief Executive Officer of Berliner and Marx. Newton, President of Formula 1, operates a large purchasing, contracting, growing, and

slaughtering operation for veal. Other conference topics include: "Overview of the Veal Market"; "The Changing Image of Veal"; "How to Raise a Calf Safely Today"; "Efficacies and Drug Product Resistance of Currently Cleared Drugs"; "Cooperating with Your Veterinarian"; and open forums to answer individual grower's questions.

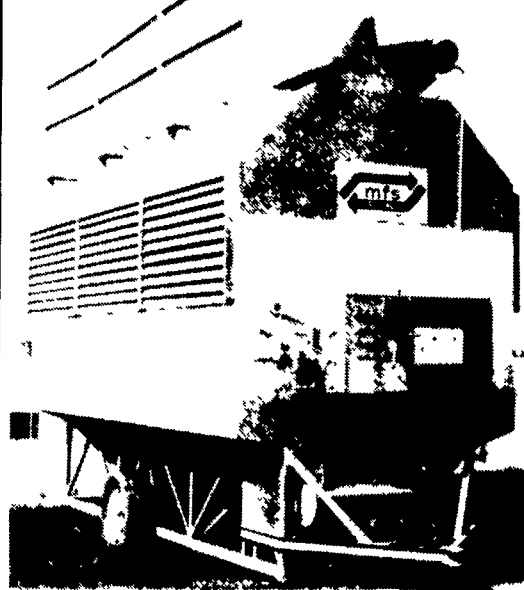
